MAIN ISSUES OF THE PROJECT

- Educate and inform them on Cleaner Production and beyond
- Foster implementation of CP strategies in Polish companies
- Collect financial sources for their activities
- Reach as many companies and organizations as possible to join the movement
- Provide consultancy on the paths to certifications

GENERAL GOALS OF THE PROJECT

Environmental : ensure that companies participating in the CP Academy and CP EVA system achieve reduction of their environmental impacts by implementing CP and EC measure

Economic : Ensure that companies participating in the CP Academy and in the CP EVA system achieve economic savings impact by implementing CP and EC measures

Social: increase public awareness in terms of environmental pollution and the negative impact of industrial processes on the environment and provide solutions to minimize them

The Cleaner Production Academy and aside contents to educate and inform people

The Cleaner Production Certificate : Consultancy until this first level of certification

The Cleaner Production and Responsible Entrepreneurship Certificate : Consultancy to the second level of certification

EXAMPLE OF ACTIONS & RESOURCES REQUIRED

- Lead the CP Academy with information concerning CP, Circular Economy, Management System, good case studies, good examples from Poland and the world, ...) with their own resources, members' contributions and grants
- Provide information in other means with conferences, seminars, debates, 2 Websites, social media (Facebook, LinkedIn, Youtube), a Journal about CP and Eco-management, ...

- Make participating companies (which attended the CP Academy) sign the International Cleaner Production Declaration of UNEP
- Receive Environmental Reports from companies that have implemented a first CP project
- Proceed to verification of the Reports by the NGO
- Issued the 2-years Cleaner Production Certificate for companies with all the requirements by the NGO

- Make participating companies (certified at the first level or with certified ISO14001 or EMAS) sign the International Cleaner Production Declaration of UNEP and the UN Global Compact Principles
- Receive Sustainability Reports from companies
- Proceed to verification of the Reports by the NGO and representatives of the Polish Authorities
- Issued the 1-year Cleaner Production and Responsible Entrepreneurship Certificate for companies with all the requirements by the NGO and a high-level jury

RESULTS OBTAINED

Economic : Many examples of success stories in Poland since the 1990s in the field of CP measures implementation and economic results from these implementation

Social & Environmental : 46 completed Cleaner Production Academies, 1064 trained institutions, 1484 handed diplomas of Cleaner Production Experts, 749 Projects (measured implemented), 248 institutions received Cleaner Production Certificates, 82 institutions registered in the Polish Register of Cleaner Production and Responsible Entrepreneurship & 322 Polish Signatories of the UNEP International Declaration on Cleaner Production including the UN Global Compact principles (260 companies, 40 municipalities, 22 intermediary organisations)
